Welcome Ceremony

We ask that everyone arrives at Stop out club (Hutt Park) for 8am on the Saturday morning, Ref briefing will take place at 8.15am sharp in front of the information tent. All Refs, club managers and captains are required to attend. Clubs will then need to be ready in their gear and lined up outside the clubhouse beside the dressing rooms to walk out and be part of the wakatau Powhiri which is a welcoming Māori blessing from the local iwi, Te Ati Awa - Kaumatua Mohi Apou.

Information desk Our dedicated team of tournament organisers are available at the information desk over the weekend at the stop out clubhouse. They'll be keeping fixtures running on track, recording scores and generally ensuring everything is running smoothly. If you have any queries, just come and say hello and they'll do their best to help out.

Gazebos will also be setup around all pitches to provide shelter to teams.

There will also independently be tents on the edge of each pitch with score keepers and organisers for more immediate questions or aid.

Food and amenities

There are clubrooms and changing rooms for use at Stop Out.

A coffee cart will be available on both days from 9am.

For lunch options:

1. A Banh Mi truck will be available for both Saturday and Sunday.
2. Simple BBQ food and sandwiches will be available to purchase from Stop Out clubrooms, with funds going towards the local scouts.

Stop out has a bar on premises for drink purchases. Alcohol can strictly only be purchased and consumed at the Stop out club; alcohol will not be permitted on the pitches.

Media Code of Conduct

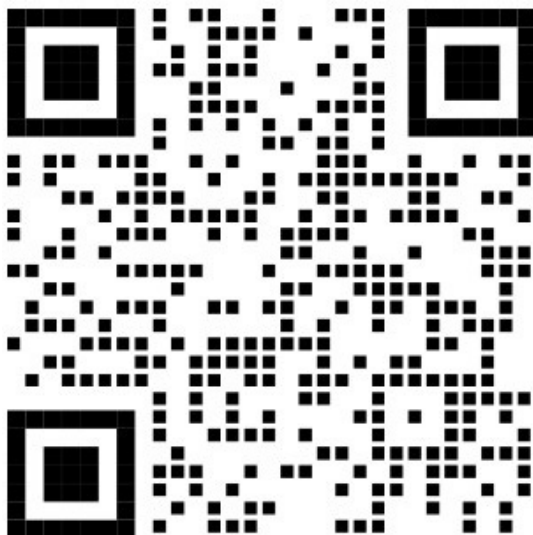
Videographers/ photographers will be there over the two days to capture all the action, this will be available to all after the tournament.

A physio will be available over the two days, there will be a \$5 charge to visit the physio with this cost being charged back to the players respective clubs.

Paramedics & Medical Services will be available over the two days to help take care of some of the (hopefully none) more serious injuries.

Refereeing:

All refs must report to the spectators table that will be allocated at each pitch, they will receive whistles, stopwatch, scorecards, pens, referee tops and x1 football for throw in.

We ask that refs arrive on time to keep the games to schedule as much as possible.

ALL ITEMS must be returned to the spectators table once your game has finished and submit the teams score to the spectators.

All refs must provide x2 umpires for their game.

We ask that all teams goal keepers bring a spare ball with them to their post ready for the game starting.
